MEETING MINUTES

Meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM by President Shorey

The minutes from the September 2005 meeting were read by Jeff Wooldridge. Motion was made to accept by Mike Yutzler and seconded by Ken Grabeldinger. Motion voted upon and carried.

Treasurer's Report:

Treasurer's report was waived.

Travel Report:

It was reported by Mike Perry that all Q games are scheduled except 19U Girls which will be done shortly.

SnowBelt Report

SnowBelt report was waived.

New Business discussions were advanced and held at this point concerning the Midget teams and Uni numbers. Discussion focused on the Uni League Midget House Team and whether to allow two Uni teams and one Snowbelt team. All teams would be full season teams and would have no effect on existing ice slot schedules.

Bill Owens moved that the maximum number for cutoff in this program will be 40 . Todd Jury seconded. Motion voted and carried.

Committee Reports:

Registration:

Bob Shorey reported that the current registration numbers are as described in the printed e-mail message dated Oct 2 that was passed out to members. Numbers are as follows; Learn to Skate 27, Mites 46, Squirts 25, Pee Wees 35 Bantams 45, Midgets 35 and Girls 19U 13. Tryouts will be held the week of Oct 3 with teams picked by Saturday Oct 8. The bottle and can drive was scheduled for Oct 15 . Lengthy discussion focused on the number of PW teams advisable (2 or 3). Ian Anderson moved that we allow 2 teams. Mark Harjung seconded . Motion voted upon and carried. 4-2 with 5 abstentions.. The subsequent Special meeting on Oct 10 covered the subject again.

Fundraising:

Mike Yutzler reported that the Ad Book is completed and waiting for print.

Scheduling:

Mike Perry reported that the website continues to evolve with many improvements. Discussion was held on the Morrisville ice schedule.

Coaching:

Bill Owens reported that during the week of Sept 26, the coaches meeting was held and that there are now only 3 certification clinics left. It was requested that by Oct 15 all Asst Coaches be selected.

A lengthy discussion was held on the state of the Bantam team coaches that will pick the teams from the 45 registered players. The issue of concerned parents expressing their wishes by letter not to have their children be assigned certain coaches was discussed . With 3 possible teams of 15 each it was agreed by consensus that all such letters will be kept confidential until the teams are selected. If further complaints are registered at that time, further action will be taken.

Jerseys:

Bob Shorey reported that all jerseys are in and ready for distribution. Discussion was held on the request of the Girls team to be provided certain jerseys from our stock. Bill Owens

moved that the request be denied and Ian Anderson seconded. Motion was voted upon and carried.

Parents Club:

No report was given at this time.

Old Business:

Discussion was held on the recent Central Section meeting and the handouts passed out by Bob Shorey. The USA Hockey Official Playing Rules Points of Emphasis was discussed, and in particular the Code of Conduct forms that must be signed by parents. The costs of the "Midget Camp" were then discussed. It was moved by Ian Anderson and seconded by Mark Harjung that for non-enrolled Midget age players, insurance will be \$37.00 and for all players a fee of \$45.00 per player will be assessed to cover ice time of the weekly sessions that are held until H.S. Tryouts.

New Business:

It was pointed out that all Board members must complete and sign the Screening Forms. Mark Harjung will investigate new Umbrella liability insurance coverage options for the Board members.

Regarding the on going desire to honor the memory of Bruce Snyder, Mark Hobaica announced that we have approval from the Town of Kirkland (Owner of the Arena) to construct a sitting/viewing area on the second floor along the wall facing out to the rink. Discussion ensued about how best to begin construction. Tony Gurdo moved and Bill Owens seconded a motion to solicit two estimates for the construction and to have CYH pay for the excess cost of the construction over and above what is available from the Bruce Snyder Memorial Fund. Motion was voted upon and carried. Tony Gurdo moved and Todd Jury seconded the motion to provide printed Bantam Practice jerseys for all Bantam teams to be paid for from the Anthony Gurdo Memorial designated portion of our fund balance. Motion was voted upon and carried.

A motion to adjourn the October meeting was made by Mike Yutzler and seconded by Todd Jury. The meeting was adjourned at 9:44 PM

The next meeting will be held on November 7 at 7:30 PM at the Clinton Arena.
